How to Apply for Fuel Assistance

Applications for fuel assistance are open from the months of September to April. Contact South Shore Community Action Council at 508-746-6707, or CACCI (Community Action Committee of Cape Cod and the Islands) at 508-771-1727.

Or, apply online at https://www.toapply.org/MassLIHEAP. LIHEAP (the Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program) assists eligible households with part of their winter heating bills.
