An open letter to all who contributed to the Cape Cod Times Needy Fund,

Cape Codders demonstrated their capacity for caring about their neighbors by raising over \$1.6 million through more than 5,700 contributions to the Cape Cod Times Needy Fund in 2021.

Those numbers represent a new high water mark for both the number of contributions and the amount raised to help Cape Codders who are struggling financially.

The generosity of Needy Fund donors reminds me of Newton's third law or motion that states for every action there is an equal and opposite reaction. As the coronavirus rages on through omicron, Cape Codders reacted with unprecedented compassion and generosity by crushing this years fundraising goal of \$1,150,000.

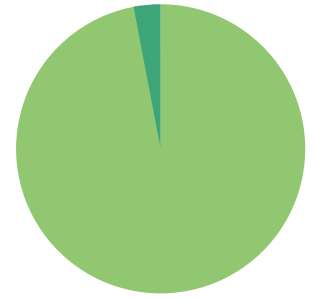

Total Revenue

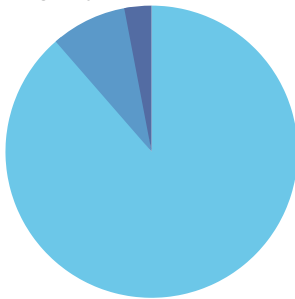

CAPE COD AND ISLANDS MAJOR CRISIS RELIEF FUND

The Major Crisis Relief Fund (MCRF) was created in 2016 as a program of the Cape Cod Times Needy Fund. Our mission is to fill existing gaps in preparing for and responding to disasters on the Cape and the Islands, helping individuals and families with urgent and longer-term needs. A hallmark of MCRF and the Needy Fund is our ability to respond quickly and efficiently to the most urgent needs in our communities. Most recently, we assisted our neighbors hit hardest by the coronavirus. At the same time, we are preparing for a potentially catastrophic storm. While we on the Cape & Islands have averted major hurricanes the last few years, it could happen at any time.

MCRF is here for the Cape & Islands.

25% reported a disability

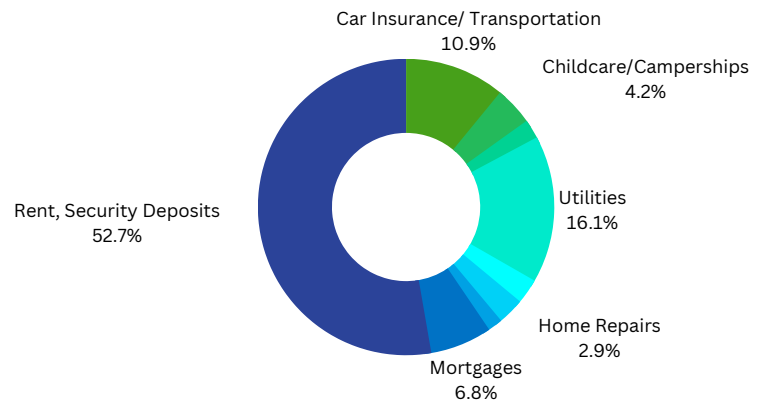
28% are single parent callers

13% receive social security disability

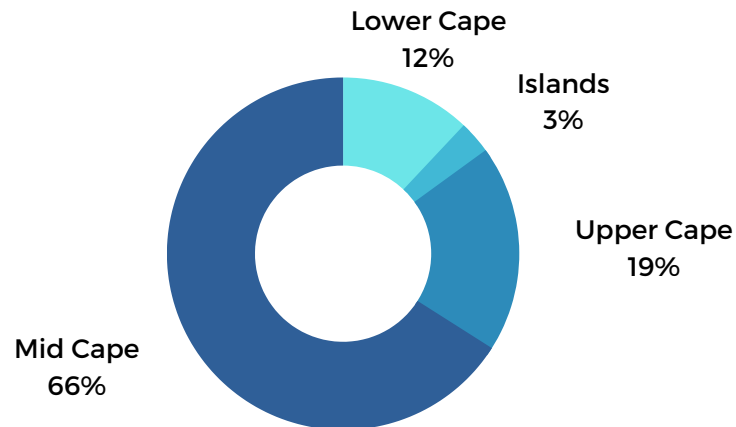
18% of callers own their own homes
